On 1 January 2010, the Group adopted the following revised Singapore Financial Reporting Standards (FRS).

FRS 27 (revised) Consolidated and Separate Financial Statements (effective for annual periods beginning on or after 1 July 2009)

FRS 27 (revised) requires the effects of all transactions with non-controlling interests to be recorded in equity if there is no change in control and these transactions will no longer result in goodwill or gains and losses. The standard also specifies the accounting when control is lost. Any remaining interest in the entity is re-measured to fair value, and a gain or loss is recognised in profit or loss.

<u>FRS 103 (revised) Business Combinations</u> (effective for annual periods beginning on or after 1 July 2009)

FRS 103 (revised) continues to apply the acquisition method to business combinations, with some significant changes. For example, all payments to purchase a business are to be recorded at fair value at the acquisition date, with contingent payments classified as debt subsequently remeasured through the profit or loss. There is a choice on an acquisition-by-acquisition basis to measure the non-controlling interest in the acquiree either at fair value or at the non-controlling interest's proportionate share of the acquiree's net assets. All acquisition-related costs should be expensed.

There was no impact on prior period earnings per ordinary share and net asset value per share on adoption of the revised FRS mentioned above.

8(a) Year to Date Results - 3 Months ended 31 March 2010 vs. 3 Months ended 31 March 2009

Food and Beverage division performance

The Food and Beverage ("F&B") revenue increased 8.7% to \$101.31 million for the financial period ended 31 March 2010 as compared to \$93.23 million recorded in the corresponding period last year. The increase in revenue was mainly due to higher sales volume. Gross profit improved by 21.3% to \$33.75 million in the current period as compared to \$27.82 million in the corresponding period last year mainly due to higher revenue.

The increase in gross profit was partially offset by:

- Higher advertising and promotion expense of \$1.63 million which is in line with the higher revenue; and
- Higher income tax expense of \$1.15 million due to higher taxable profit from Singapore and Malaysia operations.

As a result, F&B division recorded net profit after tax of \$4.09 million in current period as compared to net profit after tax of \$0.64 million in the corresponding period last year.

Property division performance

Revenue from Property division, which is recognised progressively, increased by \$4.33 million to \$6.79 million in the current period as compared to \$2.46 million recorded in the corresponding period last year. A profit after tax of \$1.98 million is recorded in the current period as compared \$0.44 million in the corresponding period last year.

The higher revenue and profit after tax is due to higher number of units of development properties sold in the current period.

Group performance

After evaluation of various qualitative and quantitative factors, the Group impaired the carrying value of some of its available-for-sale financial assets ("AFS") by \$0.6 million during the current quarter. Overall, the Group recorded a profit after tax of \$5.25 million in the current period as compared to a profit after tax of \$0.98 million in the corresponding period last year.

8(b) Balance Sheets - 31 March 2010 vs. 31 December 2009

Group

Trade and other receivables for the Group increased by \$6.08 million from \$75.81 million as at 31 December 2009 to \$81.89 million as at 31 March 2010. The increase was mainly in line with higher sales in F&B division and sales of development properties during the current quarter.

Inventories for the Group decreased by \$14.50 million from \$48.81 million as at 31 December 2009 to \$34.31 million as at 31 March 2010 mainly due to running down on inventories built up in December 2009 for the Chinese New Year festive season.

AFS increased by \$6.31 million from \$55.15 million as at 31 December 2009 to \$61.46 million as at 31 March 2010 mainly due to \$6.75 million fair value gains on quoted AFS at balance sheet date.

Trade and other payables decreased by \$4.30 million from \$81.05 million as at 31 December 2009 to \$76.75 million as at 31 Mach 2010 mainly due to settlement of trade payables, partially offset by higher accrual of advertising and promotion expense in Malaysia subsidiary.

Company

AFS decreased by \$0.21 million from \$7.18 million as at 31 December 2009 to \$6.97 million as at 31 March 2010 due to net impairment loss on quoted AFS at balance sheet date.

Investment in subsidiaries decreased from \$392.51 million as at 31 December 2009 to \$376.51 million as at 31 March 2010 due to liquidation of a subsidiary.

Trade and other payables decreased by \$16.34 million from \$269.30 million as at 31 December 2009 to \$252.96 million as at 31 March 2010 mainly due to write back of \$16.00 million payable to a subsidiary that has been liquidated.

8(c) Statement of Cash Flows

3 months ended 31 March 2010 vs. 3 months ended 31 March 2009

The Group registered a net increase in cash of \$15.30 million for the period ended 31 March 2010 as compared to a net increase in cash of \$10.45 million for the corresponding period last year mainly due to higher cash flow generated from operations. Net operating cash inflow generated by the Food and Beverage division and the Property division were \$15.35 million and \$0.99 million respectively.

Cash outflow from investing activities of \$0.78 million was mainly due purchase of property, plant and equipment of \$0.85 million, partially offset by interest income received of \$0.07 million

Cash outflow from financing activities of \$0.26 million was due to interest paid for the current period.

In the next 12 months, consumer demand and selling price in the Food and Beverage business are expected to improve. The Group will continue to focus on improving operational efficiency and cost management measures to stay competitive and strengthen its market position in Food and Beverage industry.

For the Property division, the Group will continue to drive sales of its remaining 120 unsold units of development properties in 2010.

11. Contingent Liability

In 2003, a legal action for an alleged breach of agreement with regard to contract packing arrangement was brought by FY Sdn Bhd ("the Plaintiff"), a company incorporated in Malaysia, against Yeo Hiap Seng (Malaysia) Berhad ("YHSM"), a subsidiary of the Group. There is no specified sum in the statement of claim which seeks inter alia that YHSM pays general damages.

The matter came up for trial before the court on the 25th and 26th January 2010 and the Plaintiff is now claiming for damages of approximately \$2.6 million (RM6.2 million) with interest and cost thereon. YHSM is contesting the claim and a notice of appeal has been filed on 25 March 2010. Based on the advice from its legal advisors, the Directors of YHSM are of the opinion that the claim is unsustainable.

On 1 February 2010, YHSM received a formal notification from the Central Jakarta District Court informing that the Jakarta High Court has decided in favour of YHSM and its subsidiary, PT YHS Indonesia, in respect of an appeal filed by PT Kharisma Inti Persada ("Plaintiff") in the Jakarta High Court against YHSM and its subsidiary, PT YHS Indonesia, claiming for approximately \$32 million (Rupiah 219.9 billion) for an alleged breach of an alleged distribution agreement and an alleged distributor's appointment. On 23 March 2010, the Plaintiff filed an appeal to the Supreme Court, and YHSM filed a counter memorandum to the court on 5 April 2010.
